# Preparation for Diagnostic Imaging

Study	Study Time	Preparation
Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm US Ultrasound	30 minutes	Patients should be fasting for at least 8 hours (ideally scheduled in morning).
Abdominal Aortic US Ultrasound Screening	30 minutes	Patients should be fasting for at least 8 hours (ideally scheduled in morning).
Abdominal Complete US Ultrasound	60 minutes	Patients should be fasting for at least 8 hours (ideally scheduled in morning).
Abdominal Limited US Ultrasound Abdomen Specific Area US Ultrasound Gallbladder US Ultrasound Spleen US Ultrasound Pancreatic US Ultrasound Liver US Ultrasound	30 minutes	Patients should be fasting for at least 8 hours (ideally scheduled in morning) and should eat a very low-fat diet the night before their testing.
ABI - Ankle Brachial Index Arterial, Limited, Lower Ext (includes ABI)	60 minutes	Will require the patient to remove their pants in order to evaluate the arteries of the lower extremity.
Carotid Bilateral US Ultrasound Echo with Doppler Color Flow	30 minutes 30 minutes	None Patients will need to remove shirt and any undergarments on their upper torso.
Renal US Ultrasound	30 Minutes	Patients should be fasting for at least 8 hours (ideally scheduled in morning). Patients should have a full bladder at the time of the exam (drink plenty of clear fluids prior to test).
Thyroid US Ultrasound	30 minutes	None
Venous Upper and Lower Ext Bilat US Ultrasound Venous Upper and Lower Ext LT US Ultrasound Venous Upper and Lower Ext RT US Ultrasound	30 minutes	Depending on the site being scanned, patients may need to remove a shirt (upper) or pants (lower).

## Preparing for your ultrasound:

- If your insurance plan requires prior authorization, our staff will submit the request.
- Once prior authorization is approved, we will contact you to schedule your ultrasound.

- While scheduling with you, we will explain how to prepare for the ultrasound.
- On the day of your imaging, please arrive at the imaging location 15 minutes prior to your test.
